Applications for the 2024 Cohort of the RAPTIC Program

Applications are open for submission between Nov 1-30, 2023 by any COM Faculty member of any gender.. Application forms can be obtained at wims@osumc.edu and submitted back to the same email address. Review of applications will take place at the start of December, and all accepted participants will be notified in mid-December for a mid-January start date. This program has 2 Tracks: Track 1 is IP/Commercialization focused.Track 2 targets faculty with a new translational/clinical research project with innovation components, a new MD-PhD collaboration, or a first-time research project for a clinical faculty. Both tracks feature monthly learning sessions and monthly coaching sessions, as well as monthly survey requirements.
