

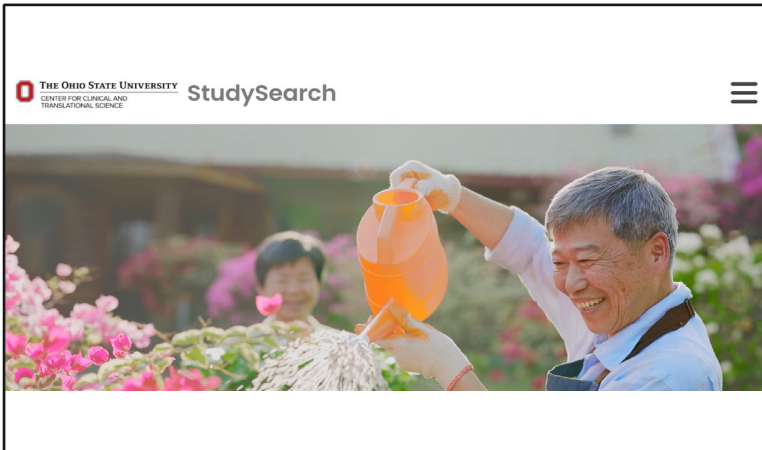
Self-Service Functionality for StudySearch

Do you have an IRB approved study that is seeking volunteers?

StudySearch.osumc.edu, is an online, plain language listing of Ohio State studies that are seeking volunteers. No additional IRB oversight is necessary to list your study. The StudySearch site regularly gets 1000-3000 visitors per month.

If your study is not already listed on StudySearch, someone from your research team can easily submit it now. Once it is reviewed and edited by the administrators to meet plain language standards, your study will be listed and available for public viewing.

1. Go to StudySearch



2. Follow the tip sheets for **Logging In**

- You will submit the formal title of the study and our administrative staff will provide a plain language title that will be seen above the formal title.
- Keep purpose and eligibility in plain language (something similar to your consent forms). Not every eligibility criteria needs to be listed.
- Be prepared to upload your most recent consent and IRB approval.
- Key words: put in as many as you can think of that will relate to this study. The site will automatically add the contact person and PI as key words.
- Once our staff has reviewed and edited your submission and have it ready for publishing, you will receive an email from StudySearch asking you to review it.
- Once you have approved any edits, your study will be published.
